Prayers for Ukraine

Prayers held on a Wednesday will relocate to St. Thomas More from Easter onwards. Parishioners are welcome from **6pm-6.45pm each Wednesday** until further notice.

About this morning's music (at 11.15a.m.)

The traditional Eastertide Marian antiphon Regina Cæli lætare ('Queen of heaven, rejoice'; for the complete text see Hymn 368) forms the basis of the Missa Regina Cæli by Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina (c1525-94) and of the motet Regina Cæli by Felice Anerio (1560-1614), both of which we hear today. Palestrina, the composer of a vast repertory of more than 100 masses and 250 motets, for more than 40 years served successively as Organist and Choirmaster of St Peter's, of St John Lateran, and of St Mary Major basilicas in Rome, returning in 1571 to St Peter's where he remained for the rest of his life. On Palestrina's death Anerio succeeded him as Composer to the Papal Choir. The Post-communion Hymn, The strife is o'er, is sung to music adapted by William Monk (1823-89) from one of Palestrina's settings of the Magnificat. Before the mass begins, we hear the Prelude and Fugue in C (BWV 545) of Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) and after mass the famed Toccata from the Fifth Symphony by Charles-Marie Widor (1844-1937), which the composer often played at the close of Easter masses in St Sulpice.
