Fr Stephen writes:- Our Lady and St. Kenelm, Stow on the Wold are making a pilgrimage to Lourdes, leaving on Monday 10th October and returning either on Thursday 13th (two clear days in Lourdes) or on Friday, 14th (three). This Parish is organising the Pilgrimage, and we currently have 27 people showing strong interest and have 30 flights held until 10th June. Cost £542 per person (£30 per night single room occupancy). This includes full board at The Eliseo hotel, flights, travel insurance. If we stay the extra day the cost would be £70 per head.
