#### Away Day Focussing on The Eucharist for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion & Volunteers

If you are an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, a Catechist of any description, an adult altar server or anybody who requires a DBS check to function as a volunteer in the parish, you are warmly invited, and indeed encouraged, to attend an away day at *Sacred Hearts Parish, Saturday, 27 April.* The morning will commence with Mass at 10.a.m in the Church.
