ABOUT TODAY'S MUSIC AT 11.15AM

We continue our series of the Eucharistic hymns of St Thomas Aquinas (ca 1225-74) in honour of the 750th anniversary of his death on 7th March 1274. Today the choir will sing O Salutaris Hostia, the final two verses of St Thomas' hymn Verbum supernum prodiens, nec Patris (written as the Office Hymn for Lauds of the feast of Corpus Christi), set to music by Camille Saint-Saëns (1835-1921). The Latin text, with an English translation, may be found in the Laudate hymn books, No. 655.
